Immunizations are not required for travel to Italy or in order to return to the U.S. However, you should be up to date on <u>routine vaccinations</u> while traveling to any destination. The U.S. Department of State recommends that you check your health records to make sure your measles, mumps, rubella, polio, meningococcal ACWY and B, diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis, immunizations are up to date. SACI recommends that students and employees follow the advice on the website of the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u>.
