SACI HARASSMENT POLICY

Harassment of any SACI student, employee, or other member of the SACI community is prohibited and violates U.S. and Italian law, and includes verbal, physical, and visual conduct that creates an intimidating, offensive, or hostile environment or interferes with work performance. Examples include racial slurs; ethnic jokes; posting of offensive statements, posters, or cartoons; or other similar conduct. Sexual harassment includes solicitation of sexual favors, unwelcome sexual advances, or other verbal, visual, or physical conduct of a sexual nature.

SACI is committed to providing a workplace free of sexual harassment and harassment based on such factors such as race, religion, color, age, sex, national or ethnic origin, medical condition, disability, sexual orientation, marital status, or veteran status.

Any student, staff, or faculty member who wishes to report such conduct should contact SACI's **Title IX Coordinator, Daniela Barbato**. Every complaint of harassment reported to the Title IX Coordinator will be investigated thoroughly and as promptly as possible. SACI will not tolerate retaliation against any faculty member, student, or employee for making a complaint to the Title IX Coordinator.
